

Resources for St. Louis City Older Adults

Twenty-eight organizations receive multi-year funding from St. Louis City Senior Fund to support services that fall under priority focus areas identified by the Senior Fund's Board of Directors: Housing, Economic Security, Homemaker Chore Services, Oral Health, and Social Isolation & Loneliness. Senior Fund's revenue comes from a portion of St. Louis City property taxes; this revenue is distributed as grants to nonprofits and government entities who provide services. Services supported by Senior Fund are free—or offered on a sliding scale—for St. Louis City residents 60 years or older. Many organizations listed have additional resources for older adults—some may have waiting lists for their services—contact them for more information.
