PROFESSIONAL IN AGING AWARD

In honor of Older Americans Month in May, St. Louis City Senior Fund seeks to recognize a person who:

- Demonstrates commitment and passion for serving and working with older adults in the City of St. Louis and contributes to building an aging friendly community through programs, service, and advocacy.
- Exhibits a commitment to action and results.
 - They may demonstrate this through leadership, implementing improvements to programs and services, and/or consistently providing support to others through collaboration.
- Goes above and beyond to work with colleagues and partners to respond to individual and community needs.

Eligibility Requirements

- A paid professional, 18 years or older, whose service area primarily includes the City of St. Louis and is directly involved in serving St. Louis City older adults.
- Work can be contributed in affiliation with a nonprofit organization, government agency, or for-profit business.
- The award is focused on recognizing individual contributions.
 - Please do not submit nominations for a group or organization.

One outstanding individual will be honored by the Senior Fund in 2025. As part of their award, they will receive financial support for professional development activities or items (e.g., conference or training support, equipment, subscriptions).
