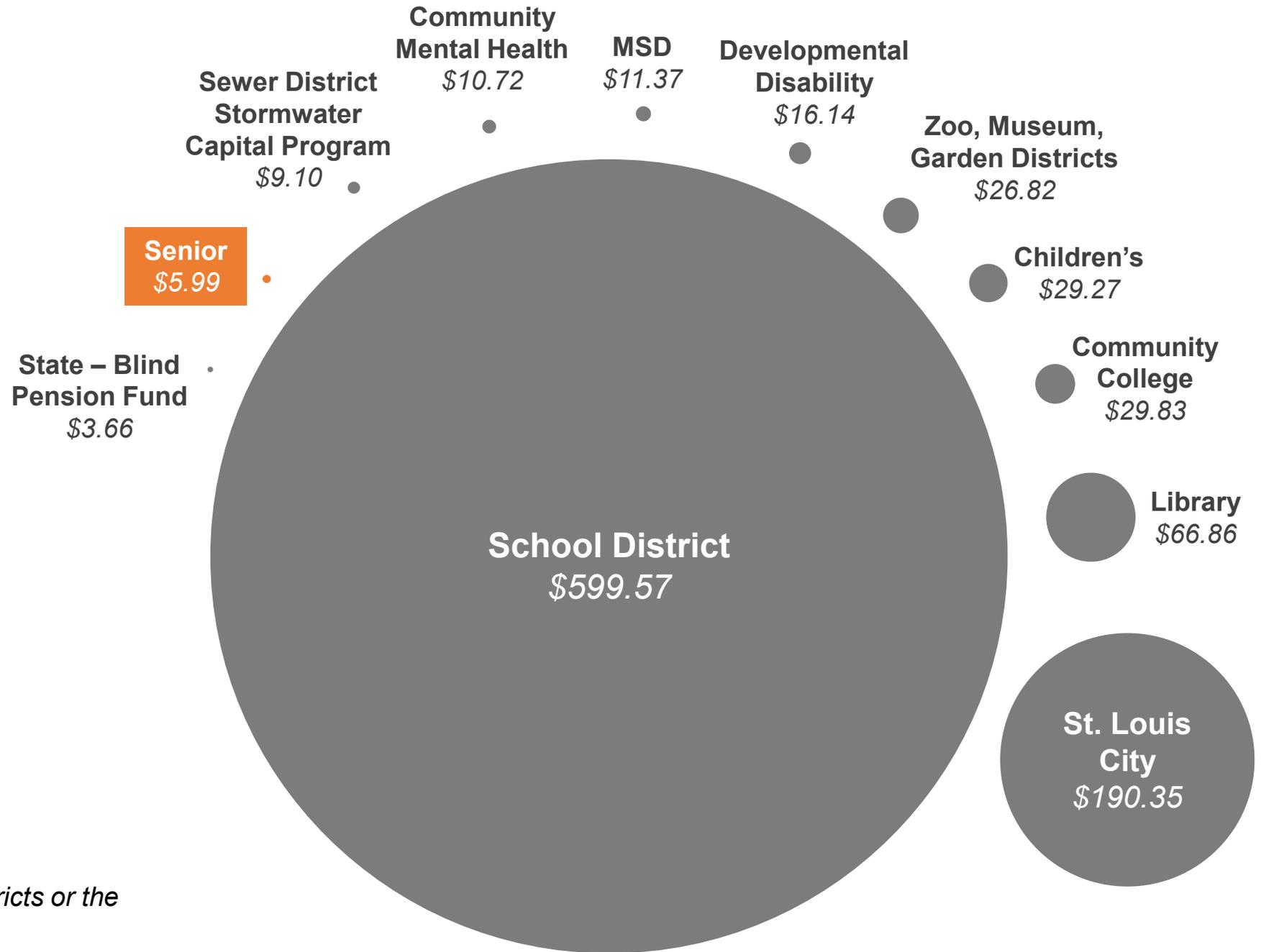

2025 Tax Rates

- We are one of several tax supported funds in the City of St. Louis.
 - Tax on all taxable property.
- Passed with voter approval in November 2016.
- Tax revenue is primarily distributed as grants to organizations to support services for **residents 60 years and older**.
 - Our levy amount, structure, and focus of the fund is outlined by state statute.

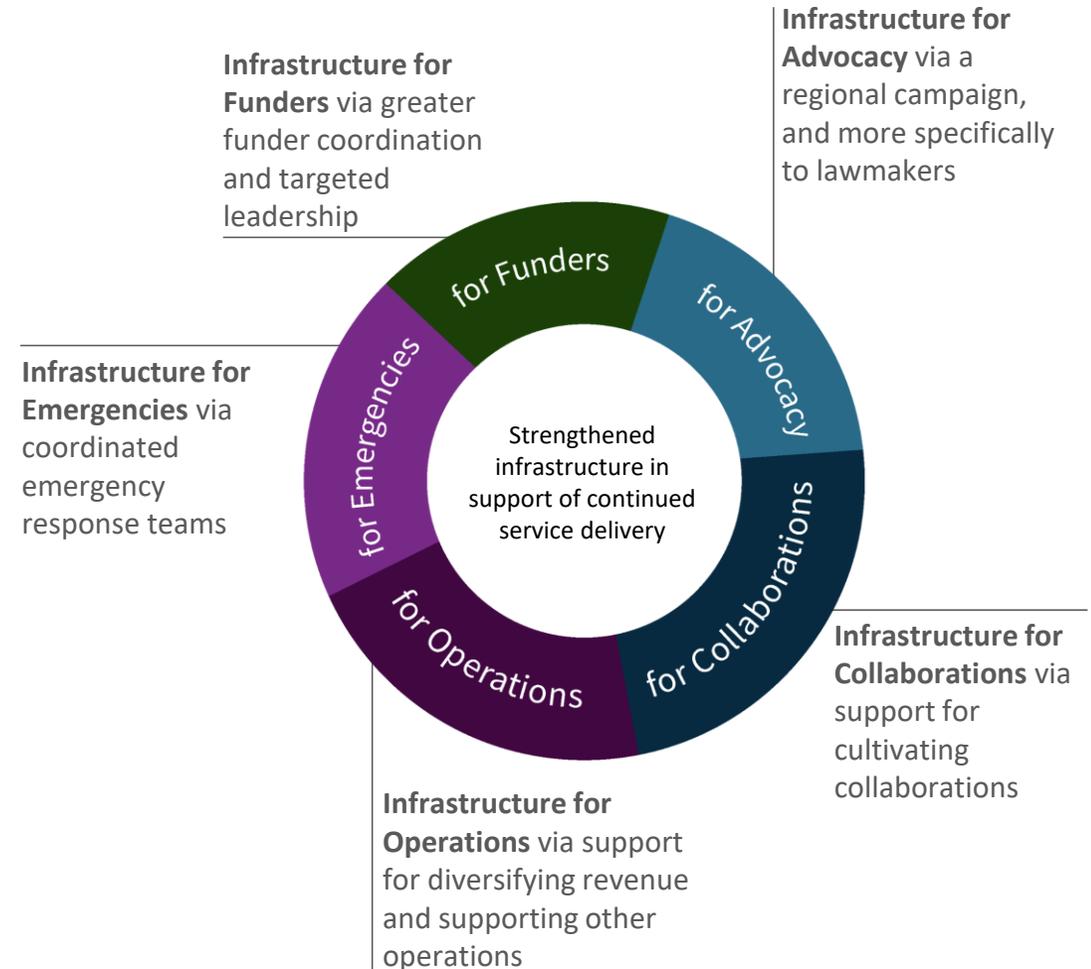

New Direct Services Grants for FY27



RFP for FY27 Grants

Accepting proposals for 1-year grants. Grants will begin July 2026.

- Applicants should:
 - Have 501c3 status or City of St. Louis government entity
 - A history of providing services to St. Louis City residents 60 years of age or older.
 - Have established fiscal policies and procedures and can provide documentation of past financial statements.
 - Only submit one proposal as the lead organization.
 - Not request more than 50% of your organization's annual budget.

Focus Areas

Applicants must provide programs or services for older adults in the City of St. Louis that fall under one of two focus areas for this funding round:

1. Caregiving Support OR
2. Case Management & Resource Navigation

Caregiving Support

Many people can continue to live at home with help from unpaid family and friends, and from other paid community services support. With this focus area, Senior Fund aims to support programs and services delivered by organizations that support unpaid caregivers and care recipients to reduce caregiving strain.

Benefits navigation and case management services play a crucial role by helping older adults understand and access housing, health, financial, and other essential programs. With this focus area, Senior Fund aims to support programs and services that help older adults access individualized support that helps them connect to needed resources.

Priorities for Grant Award Decisions

Organizations who have a history, commitment, and established local presence for serving **older adults** living in the **City of St. Louis**.

Programs and services that are:

- **Evidence or experienced-based** and adapt to and reflect the people they seek to serve.
- Have limited availability and **could expand their reach** with grant support **or are threatened to end or cut back due to changes in funding**.
- Focused on serving **older adults that have limited to no access to similar existing services** due to financial, language, mobility, or other barriers.

Grant Award Maximum

Organizations can apply for a one-year grant for up to \$75,000 in direct grant expenses.

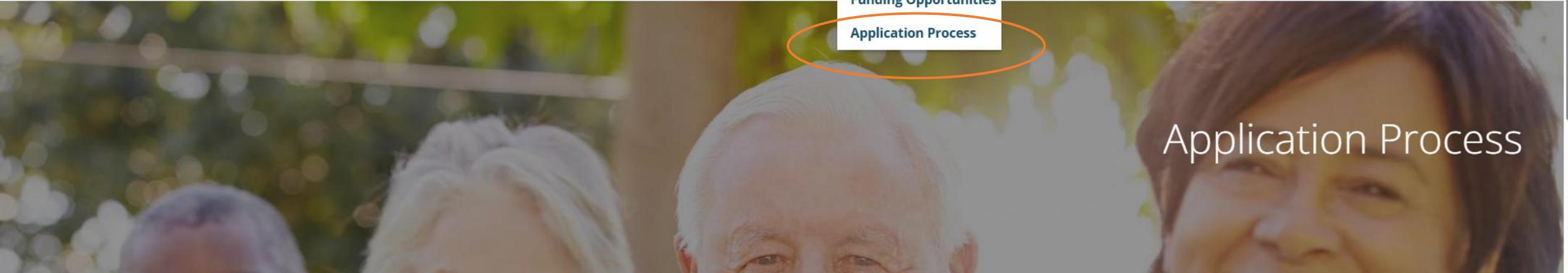
- This maximum does not include indirect or administrative expenses, which are capped at 12%.

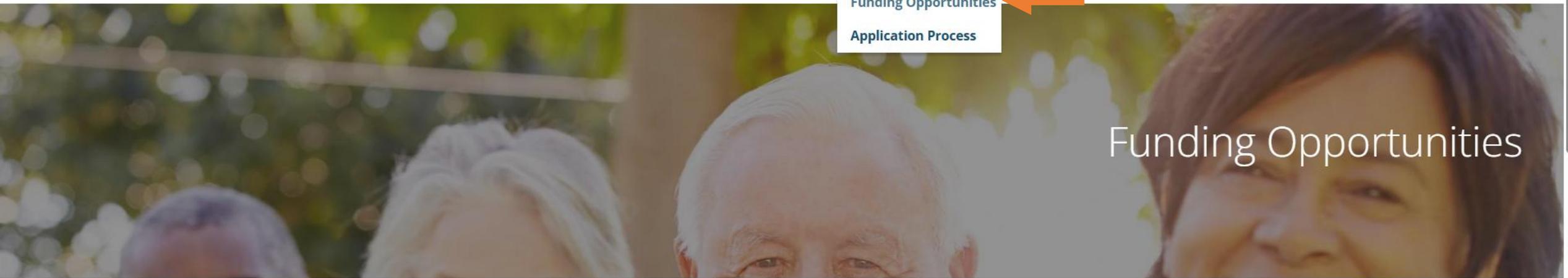

- Have demonstrated capacity to carry out program work funded by proposed grant.
- Have policies and procedures in place to manage finances and can provide documentation of past financials when requested (e.g., financial statements, IRS 990, or other documentation).
- Grants from Senior Fund are meant to build upon, not take the place of, or supplant, existing funding an organization has to support programs and services for older adults.
- Fit within the vision and priorities of the Senior Fund as stated in the request for proposals.

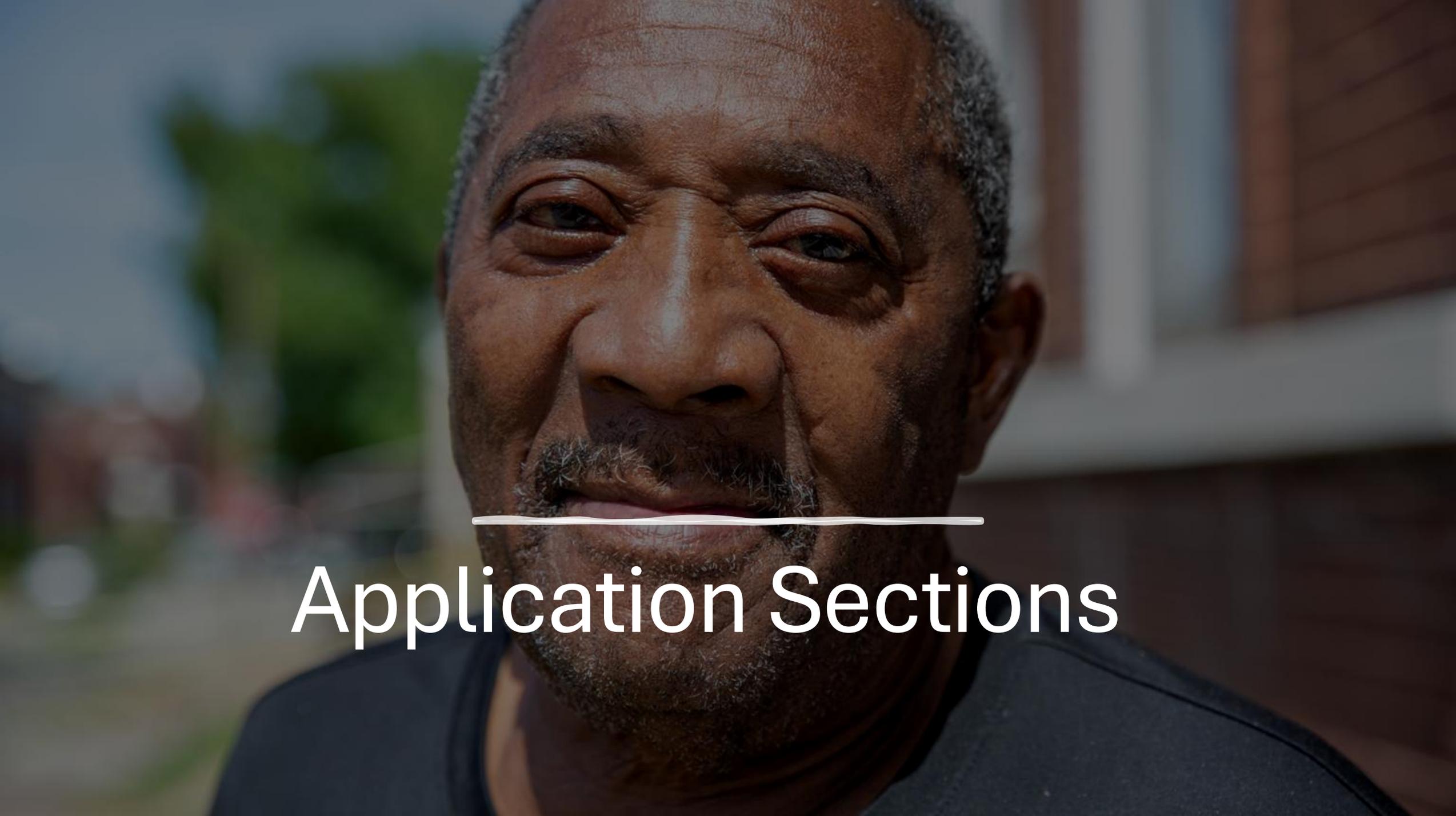
