In honor of Older Americans Month in May, St. Louis City Senior Fund seeks to recognize a person whose influence reaches beyond a single organization—someone who leads with purpose and a deep commitment to shaping what “aging in community” looks like in the City of St. Louis.

Nominees for this award can represent exceptional leadership in many ways, including those who:

- **Build bridges** across organizations and sectors to strengthen resources and opportunities for older adults;
- **Champion others**, elevating the work and needs of individuals or organizations to secure resources and support;
- **Serve as a trusted voice**, advancing awareness and advocacy for older adults and aging-related issues;
- **Take action** in moments of challenge, change, or crisis; and/or
- **Inspire forward momentum** by offering vision, insight, and calls to action that engages others.

Eligibility Requirements

- Nominees must demonstrate a clear and ongoing commitment to supporting, serving, and/or working with older adults in the City of St. Louis.
- Contributions can be made in affiliation with a nonprofit organization, government agency or legislative body, for-profit business, or as an individual advocate.
- The award is focused on recognizing individual contributions.
 - Please do not submit nominations for a group or organization.

One outstanding individual will be honored by the Senior Fund in 2026. As part of their award, they will receive financial support for professional development activities.
