- Contributes to the success of programs and/or advocacy carried out by their organization.
- Goes above and beyond to work with colleagues and partners to respond to individual and community needs.
- Exhibits a commitment to action and results.
  - They may demonstrate this through implementing improvements to programs and services, expanding resources for older adults, and/or consistently providing support to others through collaboration.

Nominees may work behind the scenes or front and center for their organization's efforts. We seek to represent the broad range of professionals working on programs and policies that support older adults in the City of St. Louis.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- A paid professional, 18 years or older, whose service area primarily includes the City of St. Louis and is directly involved in serving St. Louis City older adults.
- Work can be contributed in affiliation with a nonprofit organization, government agency, or for-profit business.
- The award is focused on recognizing individual contributions.
  - Please do not submit nominations for a group or organization.

One outstanding individual will be honored by the Senior Fund in 2026. As part of their award, they will receive financial support for professional development activities or items (e.g., conference or training support, equipment, subscriptions).
